in the Department for Inclusive Education at the Faculty of "Pedagogy and Educational Sciences" starting at the 1st of October 2018 for the field of

Inclusive education with a focus on emotional-social development and learning difficulties in adolescence.

Initially, the appointment is limited to four years (salary group 14 TV-L). The permanent position of a Senior Lecturer (salary group 15 TV-L) can be assigned in case of proof of outstanding aptitude, performance and competence after successful completion of an evaluation. Research and scientific teaching are carried out independently within the framework of the Bremen Higher Education Act (§ 24). The teaching responsibilities are eight weekly hours per semester in the position as Lecturer and twelve weekly hours as Senior Lecturer.

Bremen University is setting up a bachelor's program "Teacher Training Inclusive Education for Gymnasien/ Oberschulen" for the winter semester 2018/19 and is looking for a junior scholar with a research profile in the field of inclusive education focusing on secondary level education as well as emotional and social development and learning difficulties.

Your tasks and responsibilities

- independent, research-based teaching in the field of inclusive education in the degree program *inclusive education / special education at grammar schools and secondary schools* (esp. modules with regard to emotional and social development and learning difficulties as well as basics and fundamentals of inclusive education),
- research tasks, e.g. organizing conferences/ workshops, publishing activities and acquiring third-party funds

- contributing to the coordination and further development of the overall study program as well as performing further tasks in the field of academic self-administration.

Your qualifications (recruitment requirements)

- completed teacher training course (or comparable pedagogical degree),
- a relevant PHD in the field of inclusive education of recent date (or comparable scientific achievement)
- focus on secondary education,
- substantive focus in the field of Emotional and Social Development and / or Learning,
- experience in university teaching concerning the specified tasks.

Further are desirable

- practical teaching experience in schools and
- preferably one of the following foci: cooperation and team development, counselling; professionalization; intersectionality (esp. in regard to migration, refugee experiences of flight and social inequality); diagnostics, personalized tuition and developmental advancement in inclusive teaching,
- connectivity to the research priorities of the Faculty of "Pedagogy and Educational Sciences" and
- experience in the development of modules and study programs as well as
- international experiences,
- excellent communication skills and
- well developed media and presentation skills for teaching.

The University of Bremen aims to increase the proportion of women in the scientific field. It has received several awards in programs to promote gender equality and is certified as a family-friendly university. Female scientists are strongly encouraged to apply. Applications from persons with a migration background as well as international applications are expressly welcomed.
