in the Department for Inclusive Education at the Faculty of "Pedagogy and Educational Sciences" starting at the 1st of October 2019 for the field of

Inclusive education with the focus on teaching and didactics in secondary schools.

Initially, the appointment is limited to four years (salary group 14 TV-L). The permanent position of a Senior Researcher (salary group 15 TV-L) can be assigned in case of proof of outstanding aptitude, performance and competence after successful completion of an evaluation. Research and scientific teaching are carried out independently within the framework of the Bremen Higher Education Act (§ 24). The teaching responsibilities are four weekly hours per semester in the position as Researcher and nine weekly hours as Senior Researcher.

Bremen University is setting up a bachelor's program "Teacher Training Inclusive Education for Gymnasien/Oberschulen" for the winter semester 2018/19 and is looking for a junior scholar with a research profile on target-differentiated instruction and didactics in heterogeneous learning groups focusing on secondary education.

Your tasks and responsibilities

- Independent, research-based teaching in the field of inclusive education at grammar schools and secondary schools (especially modules on inclusive didactics as well as lectures on specific support needs in inclusive education, for example cognitive impairments)
- Independent research with an emphasis on inclusive education and didactics in secondary education as well as
- Conception and development of research center for inclusive subject didactics in Bremen in cooperation with the

subjects.

- the task profile also includes the supervision and further development of practical training phases during school internships as well as examinations, including the supervision of theses and
- Participation in coordinating and further developing the overall study program as well as taking on additional tasks in the area of academic self-administration.

Your qualifications (recruitment requirements)

- Completed teacher training course (or comparable pedagogical degree),
- Relevant, outstanding PHD in the field of inclusive education of recent date,
- Focus on secondary education,
- Target-differentiated instruction and didactics in heterogeneous learning groups as a main focal point
- Experience in independent university teaching in the described task profile.

- Preferably one of following foci: cooperation and team development, counselling; professionalization; subject-specific perspectives; students with cognitive impairments; assessment of individual learning capabilities in inclusive education as well as
- Connectivity to the research priorities of the Faculty of "Pedagogy and Educational Sciences" and
- Experience in the development of modules and study programs
- Experience in the preparation of applications for third party funding and the organization and arrangement of scientific events, as well as
- International experiences and contacts
- Excellent communication skills and
- Well developed media and presentation skills for teaching.
